The commissions and committees are responsible for researching, reviewing, and making recommendations on related issues.

All terms begin on June 1, 2010 and these positions are open to Burnsville residents ages 18 and older. Some memberships on the Economic Development Commission and the Design Review Committee are open to people that have a business located in the City. The deadline for filing applications is 4:30 p.m. on Monday, May 3, 2010 and the City Council will conduct interviews for these appointments in mid-May. Opportunities for service are available on the following advisory boards:

Economic Development Commission: Serves as an advisory body on economic development and business development issues. *Openings: 2 Regular Members – 3 year terms*

Parks and Natural Resources Commission: Serves as an advisory body, which reviews and makes recommendations on issues related to park, recreation, and open space needs of the community and protection of Burnsville's natural resources. *Openings: 1 Regular Member – 3 year term; 1 Regular Member – 2 year term; 1 Alternate Member – 3 year term; 1 Youth Members - 1 year term*

Planning Commission: Serves as an advisory body, which reviews, researches, and makes recommendations on issues related to land use and development. *Openings: 2 Regular Members - 3 year terms*

Design Review Committee (Heart of the City): Serves as an advisory body, which assists the City Council and staff in the design review of all developments with the Heart of the City (HOC) districts. *Openings: 2 Regular Members (Architect and Chamber representatives) – 3 year terms*
