







County Twin Cities Region (7-county)



Population by Race and Ethnicity in Burnsville




Employment in Burnsville


Employment by Industry in Burnsville


Forecasted Employment in Burnsville







(in \$000s)





Percent of the Burnsville Population Below the Federal Poverty Level



Housing Type in Burnsville





Affordability of New Units Permitted By Burnsville





Homeownership Rate in Burnsville








Count of Existing Home Sales by Price in Burnsville

Means of Transportation to Work, Burnsville Residents



Travel Time to Work, Burnsville Residents



Average Travel Time to Work, Burnsville Residents (in Minutes)











Commercial, Industrial, and Public and Institutional Construction Projects: Total Permit Value in Burnsville (in \$000s)







Commercial, Industrial, and Public and Institutional Construction Projects: Total Square Footage Permitted in Burnsville (in 000s)




