## **BURNSVILLE POLICE SEEKING GRANT FOR POLICE EQUIPMENT**

The Burnsville Police Department is seeking to apply for a grant of nearly \$13,000 to purchase forensic camera equipment and hearing protection headsets.

The grant application is through the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program. Grants are provided to local governments to support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution and courts, crime prevention and education, corrections and community corrections, drug treatment and enforcement, planning, evaluation, technology improvement, and crime victim and witness initiatives.
