CITY OF BURNSVILLE TO HOLD SKATE PARK PHASE II RENOVATION MEETING

Presentation on Phase II Features and Improvement Process Tuesday, Aug. 11 at 6:30 p.m.

The City of Burnsville will hold another informal public meeting to discuss Phase II improvements. At this meeting, Stantec — a California skate park design firm — will present information on features to work with the existing park layout. The presentation will also provide insight to design and the design process.

The City of Burnsville requested input from skate park users on the most desired features as a part of the Phase II development process in July 2015. The results for the top 10 desired features are:

1. Bowl
2. Stair sets
3. Euro
4. A-frame
5. Raised center with obstacles and banked ledges
6. Corners on the street course
7. Kicker
8. Quarter pipe gap
9. Bank to vert

City staff will continue working with design firms to create two or three options to be considered at a public meeting in the fall. The existing budget is \$175,000. Renovation work is tentatively scheduled for the fall of 2016.
