BURNSVILLE COMMUNITY TELEVISION NOMINATED FOR REGIONAL EMMY

Burnsville Community Television has received its second-ever nomination for a regional Emmy award from the Upper Midwest Chapter of the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences (NATAS).


The Emmy-nominated video, *"The Story of How Burnsville Became a City..."*, was nominated in the "Interstitial" category, which is for short, standalone programs. BCTV joins four other nominees in the category: Edina Community Channel 16, Carlini Entertainment, Twin Cities Public Television and Pioneer Public Television.

The video was produced by City of Burnsville Television Production Assistant Ryan Blegen, Community Television Operations Specialist Tina Wilson and Communications Coordinator Marty Doll, with voiceover provided by Anika Jackson. The video – produced for the City's 50th Anniversary Celebration in 2014 – tells the story of how Burnsville became a City using animation and old newspaper clippings. Entries were judged by panels assembled by other NATAS Chapters. Winners of the Emmy Awards will be announced and presented Saturday, Oct. 3, at Radisson Blu Hotel at the Mall of America, Bloomington.
