HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE DROP-OFF DAY SATURDAY, OCT. 3

Dakota County and City of Burnsville will hold their annual Household Hazardous Waste Drop-Off Day:

Who: Dakota County residents. ID is required
When: Saturday, Oct. 3 | 9 a.m. - 2 p.m.
Where: Burnsville Maintenance Facility | 13713 Frontier Court
Cost: Items accepted for FREE

Materials accepted for *no fee* include:

- **Household Hazardous Waste:** auto batteries; cleaners; fire extinguishers; gasoline; lawn chemicals; paint; propane cylinders and most products labeled dangerous, corrosive, flammable, poison or combustible
- **Electronics:** televisions, VCRs, DVD players, computers & accessories, stereos, cameras, fax equipment, electronic gaming systems and cell phones (Please remove ALL batteries)
- **Electric Household Items:** vacuum cleaners, carpet sweepers, coffee makers, electric knives, clothes irons, shaving equipment, hair dryers, holiday lights and space heaters
- **Appliances:** air conditioners, microwaves, clothes washers/dryers, hot water heaters, garbage disposals, stoves/ovens, furnaces, refrigerators, freezers, dehumidifiers and dishwashers
- **Scrap Metal:** lawn mowers, snow blowers and power tools (fluids must be drained), metal grills (propane tank must be separated) and metal lawn furniture
- **Tires:** (Must be separated from rim)
- **Bicycles:** any size in any condition to be refurbished or recycled
- **Document Destruction** (Confidentially destroyed by a certified shredding company. Available until truck is full.)
 - **Accepted Items:** computer paper, copy paper, envelopes, notepads, junk mail and file folders (Paper clips and staples are OK)
 - **No** cardboard boxes, binders or rubber bands

NO CARPET, FURNITURE OR AMMONIA-GAS APPLIANCES WILL BE ACCEPTED
