



Private Lessons

- Must be 3 years old or older
- Open to participants of any skating ability
- Figure or hockey skating
**We recommend private lessons for any skater in the Freestyle levels of figure skating or Hockey Tracks 3*
- 20 minute lessons*
- 40 minute practice time
- 1:1 student/teacher ratio

**Individual student lesson start times may vary from week to week.*

All Student lessons will fall within the scheduled hour.

Semi-private lessons

Semi-private lessons are available as long as two or more skaters are at the same skating ability or level. Cost would be split between the skaters.



Group Lessons

- Must be 3 years old or older
- Classes available for all skill levels
- Beginner, figure skating and hockey tracks
- 30 minute lessons
- 30 minute supervised practice time
- 10:1 student/teacher ratio

Skating Skills

Designed for people who want to learn how to skate.

- Basic marching
- Getting up from a fall
- Dips, scooters, frog hops
- Backward skating
- Two foot and one foot glides
- Bunny hops and pivots
- Parent and Little Skater (P.A.L.S) helps parents learn how to teach their kids to skate

Figure Skating Skills

Designed to enhance figure skating skills.

- Swizzles
- Crossovers
- Spins
- Turns
- Spirals
- Jumps
- Foot work

Hockey Skating Skills

Designed to develop hockey skating skills.

- Correct hockey position
- Hockey hops
- Snowplow and hockey stops
- Grip jumps
- Power turns
- Back C-cuts
- Quick starts
