**CHEMICAL LEAK AT CARRINGTON COURT APARTMENTS RESOLVED**

The Burnsville Fire Department has reported that the chemical leak at the Carrington Court Apartments has been cleaned up and the issue resolved. The issue was caused by a leak in a container of pool chemicals that were kept in a storage room.

No hazards remain on site and there are no longer concerns for resident safety. Residents are free to reoccupy the buildings and all roadways have been opened.

The Burnsville Fire Department would like to thank all of the residents for their cooperation.

**Background**

At approximately 9 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 2, the Burnsville Fire Department responded to a call about a pool chemical leak at the Carrington Court Apartments at 700 Evergreen Drive. Initial arriving crews discovered the chemicals were actively leaking causing health concerns for residents and firefighters. Two victims with minor injuries were transported to a local hospital in stable condition.

Residents of two buildings at the complex – 720 and 760 Evergreen Drive – were evacuated while firefighters addressed the situation.

The Dakota County Special Operations Haz Mat Team assisted the Burnsville Fire Department in mitigating the situation.
