Applications Due Tuesday, April 30

For residents who have thought about taking an active role in local government – now is the chance. The Burnsville City Council is seeking residents interested in serving on City advisory commissions and committees. These positions are appointed by City Council and are responsible for researching, reviewing and making recommendations on issues.

All terms begin on July 1, 2013, and are open to Burnsville residents ages 18 and older. Youth commission appointments are open to any Burnsville resident that will be a high school junior or senior in the fall of 2013. Membership on certain commissions is open to non-residents who own a business or property in Burnsville.

The application deadline is **Tuesday, April 30, 2013 at 4:30 p.m.** The City Council will conduct interviews for appointments in mid to late May.

Opportunities for service are available on the following advisory commissions:

Economic Development Commission: Advisory body on economic development and business development issues.

Openings: Two Regular Members – three-year term

Burnsville Performing Arts Center Advisory Commission: Advisory body that reviews, researches, and makes recommendations on issues related to the operation of the Performing Arts Center.

Openings: Three Regular Members – three-year term

Planning Commission: Advisory body that reviews, researches, and makes recommendations on issues related to land use and development.

**Openings: Two Regular Members – three year terms
One Regular Member – one year term
One Alternate Member – two year term**

Design Review Committee (Heart of the City): Advisory body that assists the City Council and staff in the design review of all developments within the Heart of the City (HOC) district.

**Openings: One Regular Member (Architect representative) – three-year term
One Regular Member (Chamber representative) – three-year term**
