BURNSVILLE HEART RESTART TRAINING SET FOR MAY 7

Who Will YOU Save? - Burnsville Fire Hopes to Train 6,000 in CPR

Who will YOU save if you learn CPR?

The Burnsville Fire Department and the Burnsville Mobile Volunteer Network have teamed up with the Dakota County Emergency Medical Services (EMS) Council to reduce the number of deaths from sudden cardiac arrest in Burnsville.

The campaign "Burnsville Heart Restart: Who Will YOU Save," has set the goal of training 6,000 people in CPR over the next three years. To reach that goal, the **Burnsville Fire Department is offering free, one-hour CPR classes and materials to any group or organization wishing to learn the lifesaving skill.** (The classes are in a new "Compression Only" format, and do not fulfill certification requirements.)

Each year, sudden cardiac arrest kills approximately 325,000 Americans - more than car crashes; firearms; house fires; AIDS; and breast, prostate and colorectal cancer combined. What's more, this top killer can strike anyone, at any age, without warning.
