**BURNSVILLE POLICE TO RECEIVE GRANT FOR EVIDENCE
PROCESSING**

The Burnsville Police Department will receive a grant for nearly \$11,000 to purchase and install a ducted fume hood system that will safely remove hazardous vapors created by chemicals used in developing fingerprints.

The Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) is provided to local governments to support a range of program areas including law enforcement, prosecution and courts, crime prevention and education, corrections and community corrections, drug treatment and enforcement, planning, evaluation, technology improvement, and crime victim and witness initiatives.
