CITY, CHAMBER, SCHOOL DISTRICT TO HOST ‘REAL WORLD READY’ CAREER DAY

Event - Part of Minnesota Manufacturers Week – Held On Oct. 23

In celebration of Minnesota Manufacturers Week (Oct 20-26), the City of Burnsville, Burnsville Chamber of Commerce and Independent School District 191 will hold a “Real World Ready” Career Day Wednesday, Oct. 23.

The career fair, open to Burnsville High School (BHS) students, will feature a number of Burnsville STHEM (science, technology, healthcare, engineering and math) businesses.
