BURNSVILLE POLICE TO HOLD COMMUNITY MEETING

The Burnsville Police Department will hold a community meeting to address public safety concerns that have arisen in the North River Hills area of Burnsville over the past six months.

Burnsville Police Chief Eric Gieseke will start the meeting by addressing recent crimes and neighborhood concerns. Dakota County Attorney James Backstrom and Assistant Superintendent of the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension Drew Evans will then discuss crime trends in Dakota County and statewide, the involvement of multiple agencies in investigations, and what is being done to keep criminals off the streets.

"Burnsville is and continues to be a safe community. However, we've had some recent, senseless crimes that are both tragic and unacceptable," says Burnsville Police Chief Eric Gieseke. "When our public has concerns, we have concerns as well. This community meeting is a means to have a discussion with our residents and businesses. We want to let them know what the Burnsville Police Department and its partner agencies are doing to help prevent crimes like this from occurring, and the ways these criminals are being put to justice."

The meeting is open to all members of the public. Representatives from the Dakota County Sheriff's Office, Eagan and Apple Valley Police Departments, and additional community partners will also be in attendance.
