TREE, NATIVE SHRUB AND PLANT SALE SET FOR SATURDAY, APRIL 26

The City of Burnsville will once again be selling hundreds of bare root trees, native shrubs and plants at its annual tree sale. (Open to Burnsville residents only – identification will be checked.)

What: Tree, Native Shrub and Plant Sale
When: Saturday, April 26, 7:30 – 10:30 a.m.
(or until all trees, shrubs and plants are sold)
Where: City's former Maintenance Facility
75 Civic Center Parkway

Trees

Tree prices range from \$20-\$35. Quantities are limited to two trees per household. Trees are locally grown and vary in size from 5 to 12 feet.

Shrubs and Plants

Native shrubs and plants are geared toward shady areas, perfect for areas where buckthorn has been removed. Shrubs are 6- to 18-inch bare root stock and will be sold in packs of 5 for \$5 per pack. Plants are in 3-inch pots and will need to be protected from frost for a few weeks. Pots are \$2 each or 3 for \$5. Limit 54 plants and 30 shrubs per household.

Tree, Shrub and Plant Sale Tips:

- Prepare planting sites before attending the sale.
- Call Gopher State One-Call (651-454-0002) to have utilities marked before digging.
- Arrive early for the best selection.
- Try to determine what trees, shrubs and plants you want before the sale.
- Don't plan on using a credit card. Only cash or checks are accepted at the sale.
- Plan to plant bare root trees and shrubs immediately.
- Wait until the weather warms to plant small plants.
- Protect trees, shrubs and plants against damage from deer and rodents until they are well established. Consider placing protection around them for the first few years.
- Get a permit from the City if you plan to plant a tree within the boulevard/right-of-way on your property (15 feet in from the curb).
