

Off-Street Parking

Off-street parking includes driveways, parking spaces, turnarounds and other areas on a property on which vehicles are parked.



Parking Spaces

All driveways and parking spaces must have concrete, asphalt or pavers for surfaces. All other surfaces are prohibited.

An off-street parking space may not be used for open storage or for the storage of vehicles that are inoperable or for lease, rent or sale.

Vehicles

The number of vehicles on any property may not exceed the number that can fit in the garage or driveway.

All vehicles parked or stored outside must be currently licensed, drivable and have all major required equipment/parts.

Vehicles must be owned by the property's owner, resident or their visitors.

One commercially-licensed vehicle of 22 feet or less in length may be parked on a residential property if used by a resident for transportation to their job on a daily basis.

RV and Trailer Parking

RVs and trailers may only be parked in front of a residence for 14 consecutive days. While in front, they must be parked only on the driveway surface.

Long-term storage of RVs and trailers must be behind the front setback of the home (i.e., behind the front of the house) and on a surface of class 5 concrete, asphalt, pavers or landscape rock.

On-Street Parking

On-street parking is prohibited in the City between 2 and 6 a.m. daily. During periods of snow, vehicles may not be parked on streets, alleys or boulevards or in any manner that interferes with snow removal.
