TWO CITY COUNCIL SEATS UP FOR ELECTION IN 2014

Filing for Candidates Open May 20 – June 3

This November, Burnsville residents will have the opportunity to vote – or even run – for two City Council positions during the General Election.

Candidates interested in running for one of these two positions can **file an affidavit for candidacy Tuesday, May 20 through Tuesday, June 3, 2014**. Affidavits are available through the City Clerk's Office at Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. during the filing period. The City Clerk's office will accept affidavits until 5 p.m. on Tuesday, June 3.

To file for City Council, candidates must be eligible to vote in Minnesota, be at least 21 years of age when assuming office and a resident of Burnsville. A \$5 filing fee will be assessed. Affidavits will not be accepted on Monday, May 26 when City offices are closed for Memorial Day.

A municipal primary will be held on Tuesday, Aug. 12, 2014, only if the number of candidates is one more than twice the number of individuals to be elected. For example, since there are two City Council positions on the November General Election ballot, five or more candidates would result in a municipal primary election.
