International Festival Calls for Artists for Cultural Perspectives: *Bringing Heritage Home*

The International Festival of Burnsville (IFB) and the Ames Center (formerly Burnsville Performing Arts Center) seek artwork to display at their fourth-annual "Cultural Perspectives" exhibition.

This year's exhibit is titled *Bringing Heritage Home*, and will take place from July 10 through Aug. 24, 2014. An artist's reception is scheduled for Thursday, July 10 at 6 p.m.

This year, the committee is looking for artists whose work defines or describes cultural traditions or values within their family, either symbolically or realistically. Artwork may conceptually, abstractly, or realistically visually demonstrate the artist's answers to any or all of these questions:

- What cultural distinctions are evident in the piece?
- Are you keeping your heritage alive with this depiction?
- What do you envision when you think of diverse cultures sharing traditions and values?
- Does your work convey a personal memory or story?

The show will feature two-dimensional art of any media, freestanding or pedestal mounted three-dimensional work, and textiles. Artwork will be selected based on relevance to this theme and artistic excellence. The Ames Center will provide wall hardware, level, measuring tape, and lighting for artistic works displayed in the gallery.
