BURNSVILLE SENIORS AGE 62+ INVITED TO WALK WITH NATURE JULY 24

Even though Burnsville is a fully developed suburb, that doesn't mean residents can't still enjoy a little bit of nature within the City borders.

Seniors (age 62+) are invited to participate in the annual "Senior Nature Walk" at Sunset Pond, Thursday, July 24.

Walk attendees can expect to see blooming prairie wildflowers, butterflies, resident bird species and much more. They'll also have an opportunity to learn about Sunset Pond's unique history, and information about other interesting natural features – including the invasive species that currently threaten the park.
