ELECTION JUDGES NEEDED FOR NOV. 4 GENERAL ELECTION

The City of Burnsville is seeking additional election judges for the Nov. 4 General Election. Election judges are paid \$9 per hour (including training) and must have the following qualifications:

- At least 18 years old and eligible to vote in the State of Minnesota
- Able to read, write and speak the English language
- A Minnesota resident for at least 20 days
- Cannot be related to another election judge in the same precinct (and work at the same time)
- Cannot be a candidate – or a spouse, parent, step-parent, child, step-child, brother or sister of any candidate on the ballot in same precinct

The City is also encouraging residents who are bilingual in Somali, Spanish or Russian to apply.

Election judges will be asked to dedicate two to three hours for training, and approximately 15-17 hours on Election Day. With advance notice, employers are required by law to allow workers time off to serve as election judges.

An application and skills test must be completed by Friday, Sept. 12 in order to serve as an election judge. The application and test are available at www.burnsville.org/elections, click "Election Judges."
