ABSENTEE VOTING OPEN FOR GENERAL ELECTION SEPT. 19

Absentee voting for the Nov. 4 General Election opens on Friday, Sept. 19.

A new State law has removed the need to provide a valid excuse to vote absentee. Now, any resident who wishes to fill out an absentee ballot may do so at:

Where: Burnsville City Hall, 100 Civic Center Parkway
When: 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday
City offices will also be open for absentee balloting on
Saturday, Nov. 1 from 10 a.m. to 3 pm., and
until 5 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 3

Absentee ballots may also be applied for online and submitted via mail. Absentee ballot and voter registration applications can be accessed at www.burnsville.org/elections by clicking on the link "mnvotes.org." Voters can also contact the Election Hot Line at 952-895-4433 or City Hall at 952-895-4490 to request an application for an absentee ballot via mail.

The Burnsville City Council, which is elected at-large, will have two seats up for election in November.
