## **BURNSVILLE INVITES STUDENT ELECTION JUDGES FOR NOV. 4 GENERAL ELECTION**

Students who have ever joined their parents to vote and been interested in the process are now invited to take part as student election judges during the Nov. 4 General Election.

Students must:

- Be at least 16 years old on the date of the election
- Be a citizen of the United States (Identification may be required)
- Be a resident of Dakota County
- Be able to read, write and speak the English language
- Be enrolled in high school or be home-schooled
- Have parental and school permission
- Complete an online application
- Attend an Election Judge training session

Student Election Judges CANNOT:

- Be related to another election judge in the same precinct and work at the same time
- Be a candidate's child, stepchild, sibling or stepsibling

Student Election judges will be asked to dedicate two hours for training, and approximately eight hours on Election Day. Students are paid \$9 per hour for training and time spent at the precinct.
