KEALEY, COUGHLIN REELECTED TO BURNSVILLE CITY COUNCIL

Incumbents Dan Kealey and Bill Coughlin were both reelected to the Burnsville City Council during the Nov. 4 General Election.

In the four-person race for two City Council seats, incumbent Kealey was the top vote getter. Kealey, who was first elected in 2006, earned his third term on the Council. Coughlin was reelected to a second term on the Council. He was first elected during a Special Election in 2011.

Both will serve four-year terms that expire Dec. 31, 2018.

Burnsville’s City Council Members and Mayor all serve “at large,” and are elected by all voters within the City.
