LOW-COST RAIN BARRELS, COMPOST BINS AVAILABLE

Recycling Association of Minnesota (RAM) is partnering with cities and counties throughout Minnesota to bring residents affordable rain barrels and compost bins.

Burnsville residents can order these items online at www.RecycleMinnesota.org, and pick them up during *I Love Burnsville Week* on June 6.

Please note that all orders must be picked up on June 6, no exceptions.

Using a rain barrel helps conserve natural resources by using rain water rather than water from the spigot. It can also reduce storm water runoff, which is a major polluter of waterways. Using a compost bin can reduce more than 25 percent of a user's waste from going to a landfill.

These compost bins come with a 10-year warranty and are made from recycled content. **Compost bins are \$55 and rain barrels are \$69** through this sale. Regularly priced compost bins cost approximately \$105, while regularly priced rain barrels cost approximately \$139.
