BURNSVILLE YOUTH COLLABORATIVE SEEKS MEMBERS FOR YOUTH ADVISORY BOARD

The Burnsville Youth Collaborative (BYC) is a new initiative in Burnsville meant to provide a framework for local organizations to partner with young people. The initiative hopes to use new afterschool and daytime programs to provide opportunities for area youth to develop, feel empowered and prepare for success.
