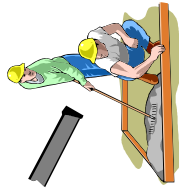


## Parking Surface Installation



A permit is not required for the installation of driveways or landscaping, but here are a few things you should know. All permanent driveway or parking surfaces (like concrete or asphalt) must be kept a *minimum* of five feet from the side lot line. **You may have an easement that requires a greater distance.** Other surfaces, like rock or pavers may go to the property line but your trailer or RV can not be closer than 2 feet. All surfaces and parking must be a *minimum* of eight feet from the rear lot line, **again an easement may require more.**

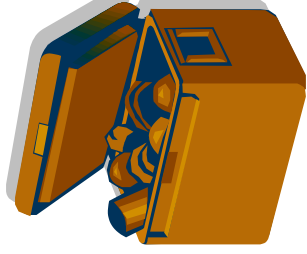
## GENERAL REGULATIONS

The parking and storage of trailers and camping vehicles is regulated by city ordinance (6-10-4). The rules apply to residential property and are as follows:

- ⇒ **Trailers and camping vehicles may be parked in the front of a home** and only on the established driveway surface of concrete, asphalt or pavers **for a maximum of 14 consecutive days.**
- ⇒ Long term storage of trailers and camping vehicles must be behind the front setback of the home and on a surface of class 5, concrete, asphalt or pavers.
- ⇒ **All trailers and camping vehicles must be clean, well kept and remain currently licensed.**
- ⇒ The owner or tenant of the property must also own the trailer or camping vehicle.
- ⇒ You may not occupy camping vehicles parked or stored on the property.
- ⇒ **No more than two trailers or camping vehicles may be stored outside** on a property less than one acre in size.
- ⇒ A boat, snowmobile, ATV or other vehicle when stored on a trailer may be counted as one vehicle.
- ⇒ **Open cargo and utility trailers may not be used for open storage of rubbish or other types of property.**
- ⇒ The maximum length for any trailer or RV stored outside is forty feet.

## Other types of Exterior Storage



As a general rule (10-7-21), **exterior storage of any kind or type is prohibited.** Some exceptions include patio furniture and cooking appliances that are specifically designed for exterior use. A second exception would be a boat, snowmobile or ATV when kept on a legally stored trailer.
