



Greetings from the Burnsville Economic Development Team!

We have some exciting funding news to share about the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Targeted Economic Injury Disaster Loan (EIDL) Advance grant program. Until now, the \$25 billion program was by invitation only. In June, the SBA says it will open the program to any small business that meets the eligibility criteria.

The updated eligibility criteria include small businesses located in specific neighborhoods and small businesses that experienced a significant drop in revenue due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

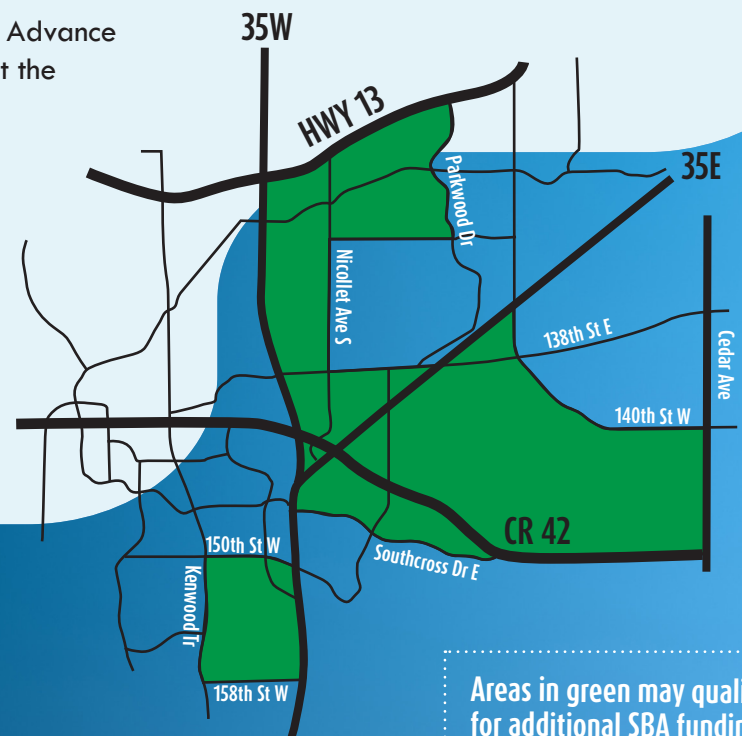
The City of Burnsville has identified your business as one of several hundred businesses in the community that may be eligible to apply for this additional funding. We encourage you to apply for this grant as soon as possible before the budget is expended.
